#### THE BIG PICTURE!

"Truly, truly, I say to you, you are seeking me, not because you saw signs, but because you ate your fill of the loaves. Do not labor for the food that perishes, but for the food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give to you" (Matt.6:26-27). July 6th-13th: Nebraska Mission Trip, RSVP on Band App. Open to All M.S. and H.S.

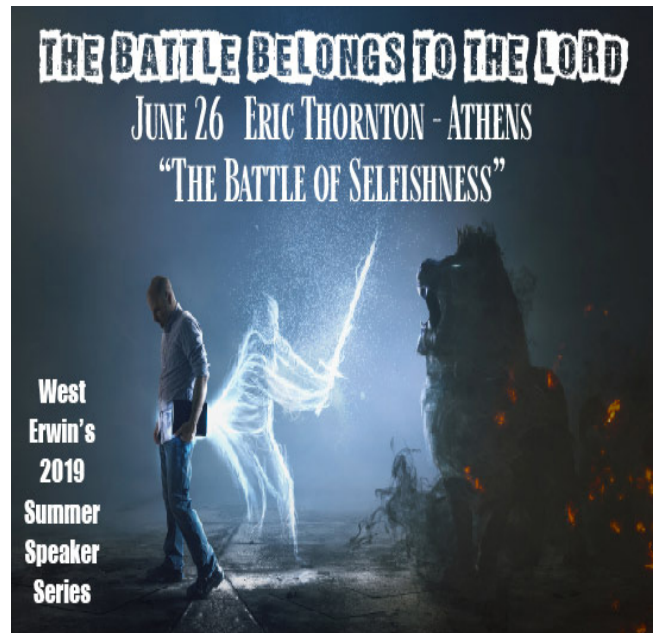
July 24th – 28th Middle School R.O.P.E. Experience RSVP on Band App.
