One of the most often cited parables of Jesus is "The Parable of the Sower." However, I don't think that's a very accurate title. It seems to me that the parable is not really about the sower. It doesn't even seem to be about the seed, which the Lord Himself says "is the Word of God" (Luke 8:11).

It's really more about the soil. Or rather, the different types of soils.

When we don't produce a crop of faithfulness we want to blame someone or something, and make excuses, rather than examining ourselves. The parable Jesus tells here does not at all affirm the excuses and circumstances we might point to and instead focuses on the kind of soil we are as we hear the Word of God.

So, in The Parable of the Soils—what kind of soil are you?

WAITING UNTIL THE END!

One of the things we struggle with is how does God allow good things to happen to bad people? They seem to have it all, and we struggle to get by sometimes. How do we overcome those feelings? I believe Psalm 73 gives us some lessons on this. The writer gives us the reason for our struggle. "For I was envious of the arrogant when I saw the prosperity of the wicked" (73:3). It is our nature to be envious of those who have more. The issue of envy is a spiritual problem. Let's look at what the unbeliever fails to recognize in their quest for prosperity. Their own pride is their enemy! "Therefore pride is their necklace" (73:6). They fail to realize that all things come from God and not their own hands. Their speech goes against God's goodness! "They set their mouths against the heavens" (73:9). They fail to realize the damage they do to their soul. They don't realize God's knowledge! "And they say, How can God know?" (73:11) They fail to realize they are setting themselves against the all-knowing and all-powerful God! So, how did the writer come to grips with this? "But when I thought how to understand this, it seemed to me a wearisome task, until I went into the sanctuary of God; then I discerned their end" (73:17). How ironic is that? The one person that the writer blamed is the one person that can heal the hurt. When we get closer to God, we get closer to peace. "For behold, those who are far from you shall perish, you put an end to everyone who is unfaithful to you. But for me, it is good to be near God; I have made the Lord God my refuge" (73:27-28).

In Romans 7:18 Paul speaks of himself stating, "For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me, but to do that which is good is not." But, in Romans 7:25 Paul also writes, "I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then I of myself with the mind, indeed, serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin."

The battle is real, but "the battle belongs to the Lord." Only in Christ will you win the war over carnal living. Put on your Christian armor, take up the shield of faith and march forward Christian soldier.


