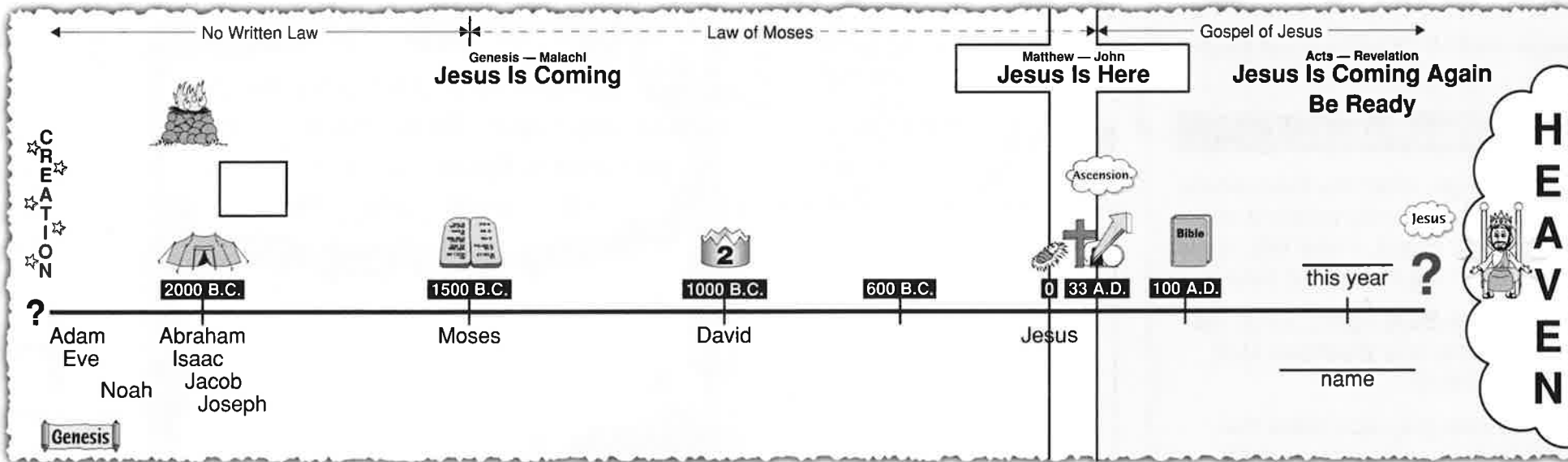
**Memory Workout**

**Guess What...**

God told Jacob that his family would come back to Canaan. God led Jacob's family back to Canaan about four hundred years later. The story of their return is in the second book of the Old Testament, the book of (*Exodus Mark*).

Egyptians did not like shepherds, so Jacob's family was allowed to live separate from the Egyptians and keep their own customs.

2. Read the Bible verse. Fill in the blanks. Write four promises God made to Jacob.

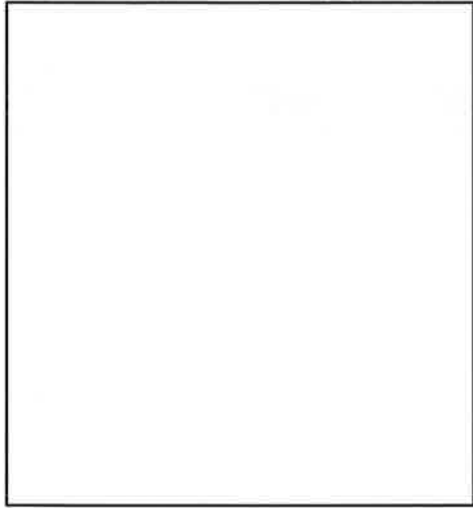
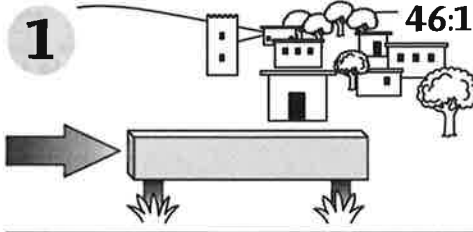
