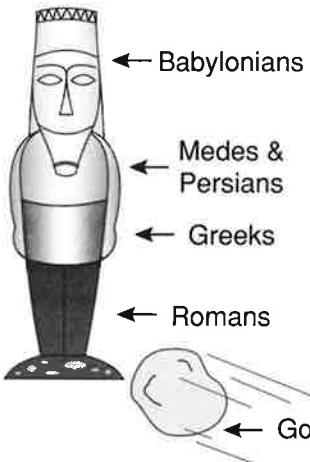

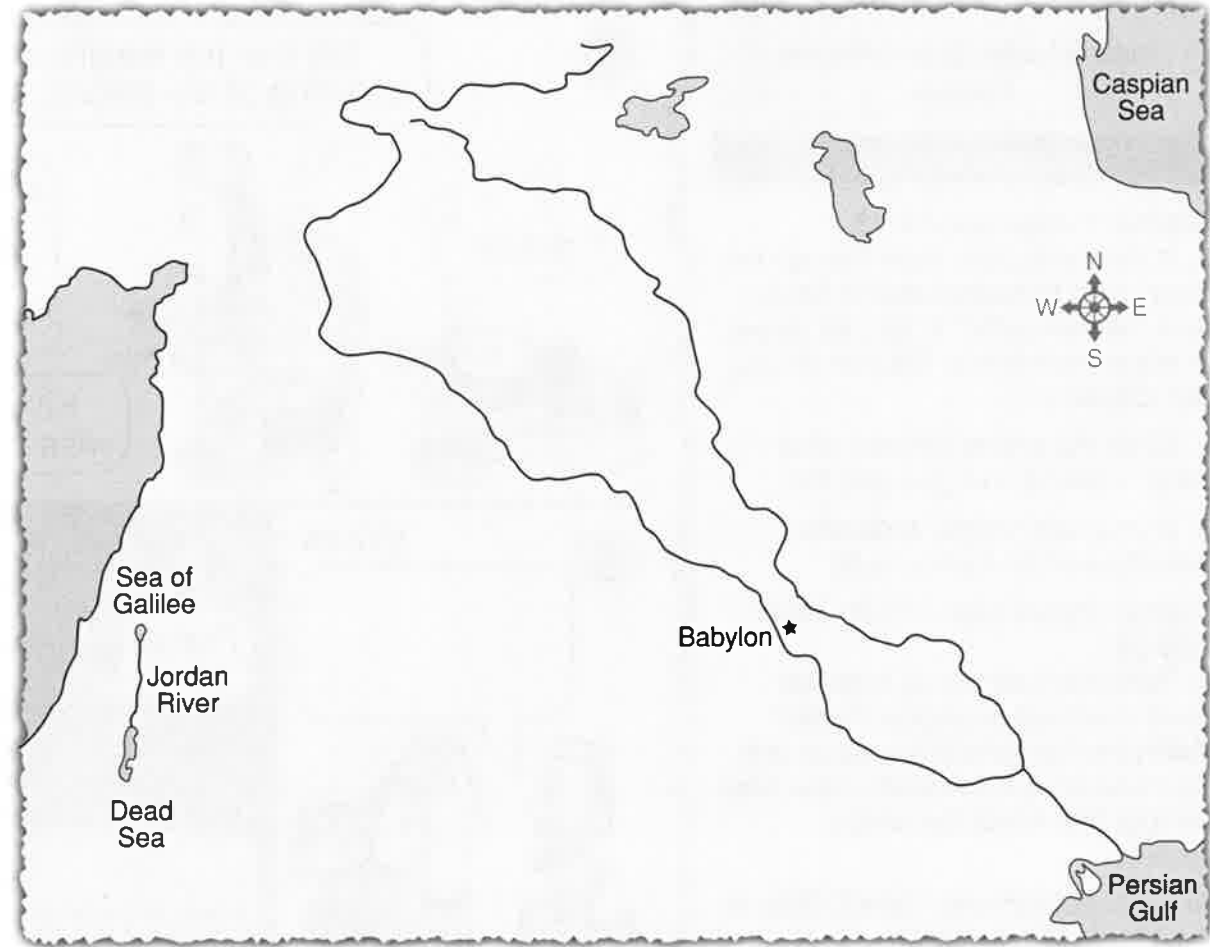
**Guess What...**



The statue in Nebuchadnezzar's dream was about the kingdoms that would come after the Babylonian empire. The Medes and Persians conquered the Babylonians, the Greeks conquered them, then the Romans conquered the Greeks. During the Roman empire, Jesus came to earth and began God's eternal kingdom. Jesus is now king.

**Map**

1. Daniel was from the part of Canaan called Judah. Place a **J** for Judah between the Dead Sea and the Mediterranean Sea.
2. Label the Tigris River and the Euphrates River. (The Tigris River is on top. "Tigris" and "top" both begin with T.)
