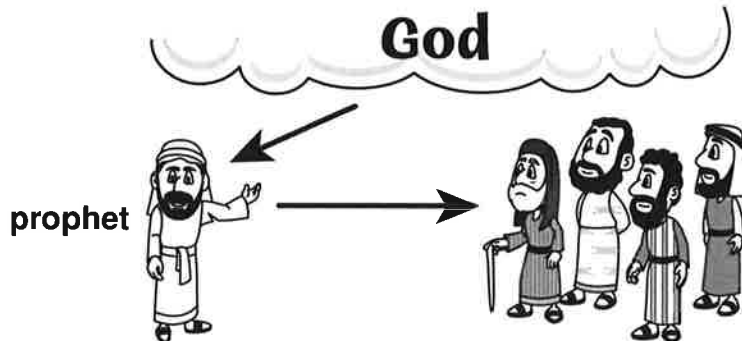
Memory Workout

Your job is to define humility. When you come up with a definition, write it down on paper.

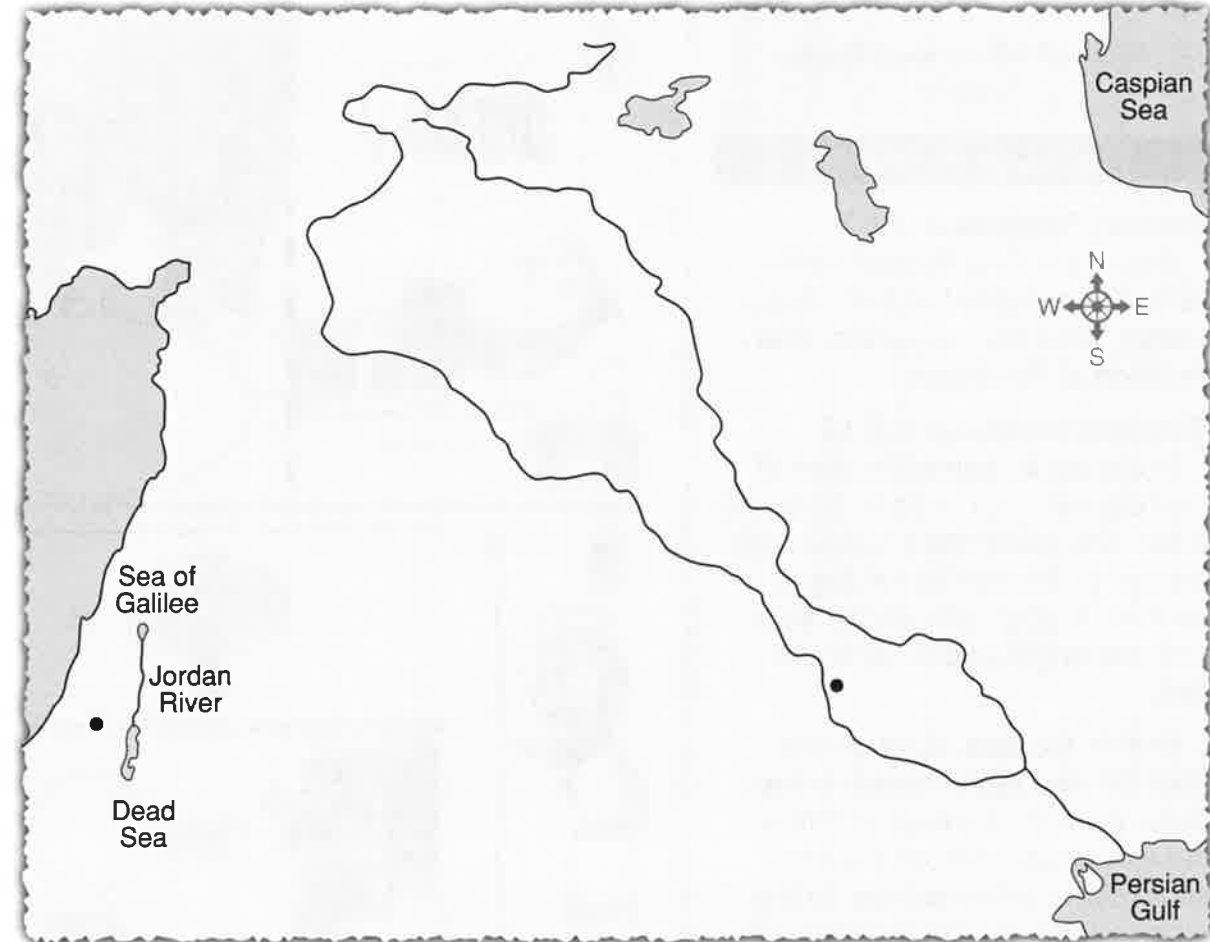
Share your definition with the class.
