The people of Judah, the Jews, were kept in Babylonia for **70 years**. Cyrus, king of Persia, conquered the Babylonians and let the people of Judah go back to their home and rebuild the temple (2 Chronicles 36:22-23). Some of the Jews went back to Canaan and lived, but Daniel stayed in Babylonia.

Darius the Mede may have been a ruler that Cyrus put in charge of the land of Babylonia.

Divide into groups of three or four. Appoint one member in each group to write down your ideas.

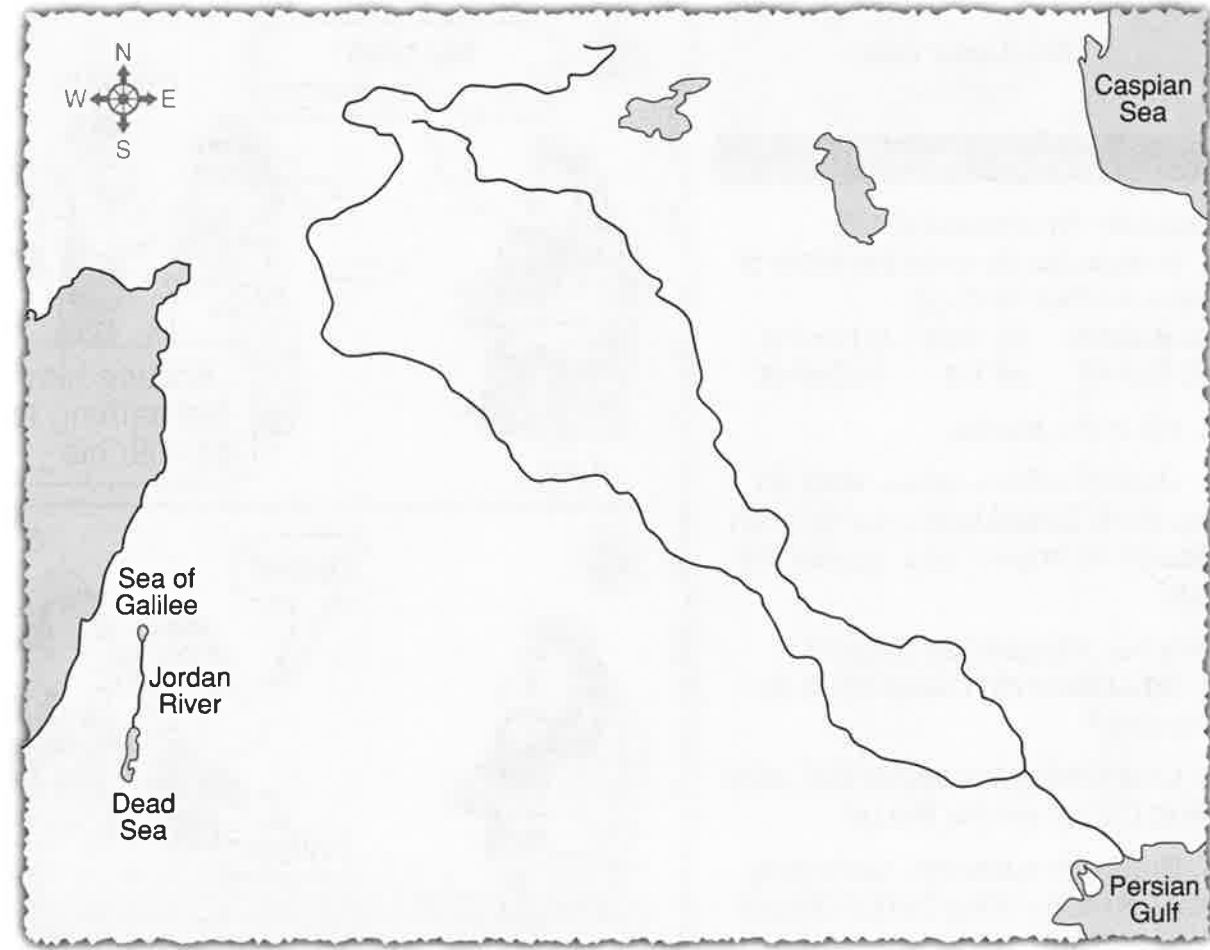
Discuss this question: Why do we need to pray to God? Write down as many reasons as you can.
