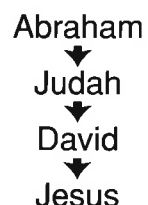
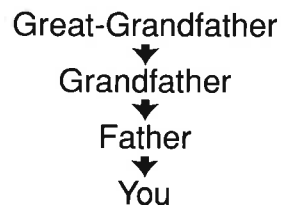
Memory Workout

- Name the first four New Testament books. Add Acts. Acts is the only book in the History division of the New Testament. It tells the history of the early church.

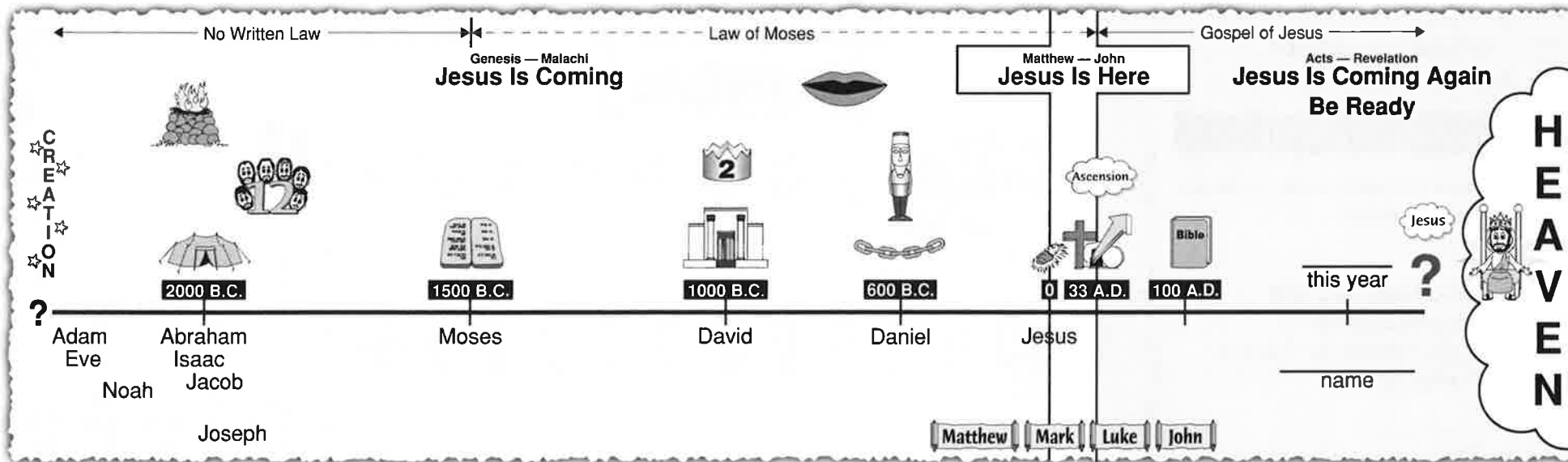
Guess What...

A list of the relatives who lived before you is your **genealogy**.

The genealogies in Matthew and Luke show that Jesus is a descendant of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Judah and David.



The word **Christ** means “anointed one.” When a man was made priest or king, his head was anointed with oil. In the Old Testament, God said he would send a special man to become king and set up a kingdom that would last forever. The Jews were waiting for the Christ to come.

2. In Luke, the genealogy of Jesus begins with what man?

Read the Bible verse. **Who** was really Jesus' father?

3. Matthew was a Jew (Israelite), a descendant of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. He started his genealogy with Abraham, the father of the Jews. Luke was a Gentile (a person who is *not* a Jew). He began his genealogy with Adam, the father of all people. In both genealogies, circle the father of the Jews. In both genealogies, place a check ✓ above the son of Jacob who is in Jesus' family. Read Jacob's blessing to this son in Genesis 49:10.

6. Draw a box around the names of four women in Jesus' genealogy (see Matthew).

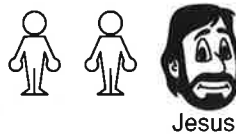
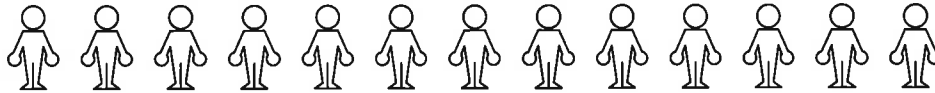
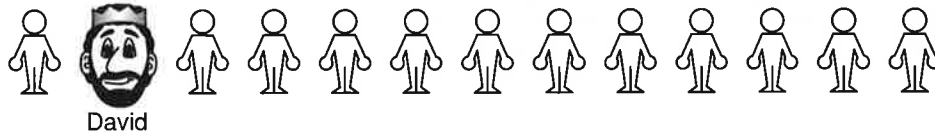
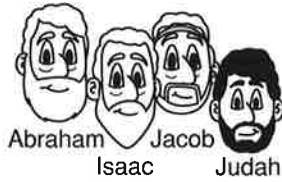
