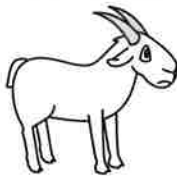

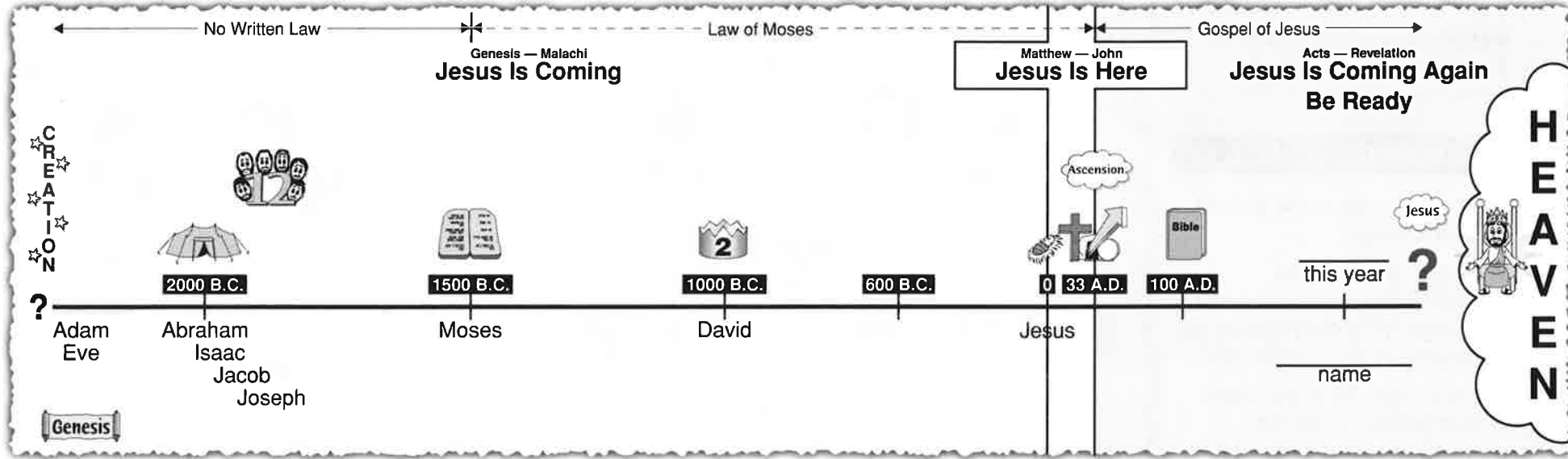
Memory Workout
